

GAS-OIL RATIO TESTS

No well will be assigned an allowance greater than the amount of oil produced on the office in 1967.

During gas-oil ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top milk allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowables when authorized by the Division.

Gas volume must be reported in MCP measured at a pressure base of 13.13 psia and a temperature of 60°F. Gasally generated heat will be 0.60.

Report casting pressure in flow of tubing pressure for any well producing through casing.

Mail original and one copy of this report to the district office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in accordance with Rule 303 and appropriate pool rules.
