Nearburg Producing Company hereby requests approval for a temporary abandonment that shut-in status of the captioned well for a 12-month period from the date hereof. Nearburg has previously tested this well and filed the appropriate Completion Reports, evidencing that the well is capable of production in commercial quantities. However, the well cannot be produced without electrification due to the need to run a submersible pump to produce the well. Electrification is not readily available in this area. We anticipate that Central Valley Electric Cooperative may install 3-Phase electrical power to within two miles from the well location on or before December 31, 1997. After the electrification is brought to within said distance, it will be required the Nearburg extend the electric line through the Chama Federal well. We anticipate this could take place in 1998.
