No well will be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on the official test.

During gas-well ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top unit allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowances when authorized by the Commission.

Gas volumes must be reported in MCP measured at a pressure base of 15.025 psia and a temperature of 40° F. Specific gravity base will be 0.60.

Revert coating pressure in lieu of tubing pressure for any well producing through casing.
