

- D. Ponds or Streams: Lake Avalon, located on the Pecos River is about 7 miles east.
- E. Residences and Other Structures: The nearest occupied facility is the Gas Company of New Mexico Plant which is located about 1.5 miles northeast.
- F. Archaeological, Historical and Other Cultural Sites: No Cultural sites were noted during the on-site inspection. An archaeological survey was conducted by Archaeological Survey Consultants and a report will be furnished to BLM.
- G. Land Use: The surface is used for cattle grazing.
- H. Surface Ownership: The S/2 Sec.15 is Public surface. Grazing rights are held by W.M. Truitt Estate, Queen Rt., Carlsbad, N.M., Phone 505-457-2368. The portion of the new road which is in Sec.22 is on surface owned by the State of New Mexico. The grazing lessee of the State surface is Marvin L. and Mary M. Watts, P.O. Box 56, Carlsbad, N.M.


