

### 1. EXISTING ROADS:

A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the surface location of the proposed well as staked. Point "A" on the plat is on 62-180, approximately 14 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico, at Milepost 47.5, where Eddy County road 238 goes north. To go to the proposed well site from this point exit 62-180 onto Eddy 238 and go north 2 miles to arrive at Point "B" where Eddy 238 turns west. Do not turn west but continue north on the caliche road 1.7 miles and the well location stake will be on the east side of the road at a distance of about 300 feet.

B. Exhibit "B" shows existing pertinent roads in the vicinity of the proposed well site. Existing roads are color coded.

### 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

A. Length and Width: The new road will be 12 feet wide and approximately 50 feet long, and is shown labeled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The centerline of the proposed new road is staked and flagged.

B. Surfacing Material: Caliche. Watered, compacted, and graded.

C. Maximum Grade: Less than one percent.

D. Turnouts: None needed.

E. Drainage Design: The new road will be crowned with drainage to the side.

F. Culverts: None needed.

G. Cuts and Fills: None required.

H. Gates and Cattle Guards: None needed. No fences involved.

### 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

A. Existing wells in the immediate area are shown on Exhibit "B".
