4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES.

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN SANTA FE ENERGY OPERATING PARTNER, L.P. Right Hand Canyon Federal No. 1 1980' FNL & 990' FWL Section 34, T21S, R24E Eddy County, New Mexico

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This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed by rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS.

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A. Exhibit E is a 15 minute topographic map which shows location of the proposed wellsite and roads in the vicinity. The proposed location is situated approximately 15 miles west of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

DIRECTIONS:

- Traveling west on Hwy 137 go 6.5 miles from the intersection of Hwy 137 & 285. After crossing the bridge across the water filled arroyo, continue west until the road curves north. Turn south on lease road. Continue south and then west for 3 miles on lease road to location.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.

A ripped & abandoned road from Hwy 137 to a dry hole by Champlin Petroleum, in Section 34 will be graded and packed for use. New construction will be built from the dry hole west to the location. Approximately 1 mile of 14' wide road will be constructed.

- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS.
  - A. The well locations in the vicinity of the proposed well are shown in Exhibit F.
