Re: Diligent drilling operations for the Bandana Unit No. 2

Dear Ms. Mauritsen:

We are in receipt of your non-commercial well determination dated September 2, 1993, on the Bandana Unit No. 01 well, located 2310' FNL & 660' FEL, Section 20, T. 22 S., R. 24 E., Eddy County, New Mexico. We concur that the well is not capable of producing unitized substances, and therefore is not entitled to receive a participating area.

According to Section 9 of the Unit Agreement, " Until the discovery of unitized substances capable of being produced in paying quantities, the Unit Operator shall continue drilling one well at a time, allowing not more than six (6) months between the completion of one well and the commencement of drilling operations for the next well, until a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities is completed...."

The spud date for the Bandana Unit No. 02 well will be October 23, 1993.
