MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit A is a portion of the BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 28 miles Northeast of Artesia New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Go south of Artesia on Highway 285 for approximately 23.4 miles.
- 2. Turn west on Highway 137 for approximately 4.5 miles.
- 3. New road starts here thru cattle guard north side of road.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 2.5 miles in length following a two tract road from the point of origin to the north east corner of the drilling pad. The road will lie in a(n) south to north direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on one side. Some traffic turnout will be built.
- D. The route of the road is visible.
- E. Existing roads will be maintained in the same or better condition.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELL

- A. There is no drilling activity within a one-mile radius of the wellsite.
- B. Exhibit D shows existing wells within a one-mile radius of the proposed wellsite.
