- 1. EXISTING ROADS Area map, Exhibit "A", is a reproduction of the U.S.G.S., Carlsbad West Quadrangle 7.5 minute series. Existing and proposed roads are shown on the exhibit. All roads shall be maintained in a condition equal to that which existed prior to start of construction.
  - A. Exhibit "A" shows the proposed development well site as staked.
  - B. From Carlsbad, New Mexico, travel North on U.S. Highway 285 for approximately 5 miles. Turn South through cattleguard to location on the left.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS Approximately 1000' linear feet of new access road will be constructed.
  - A. The access road will be crowned and ditched to a 12'-00" wide travel surface with a 40' right-of-way.
  - B. Gradient on all roads will be less than 5.00%.
  - C. No turnouts will be necessary.
  - D. If needed, road will be surfaced with a minimum of 4" of caliche. This material will be obtained from a local source.
  - E. Centerline for the new access road has been staked and flagged. Earth work will be as required by field conditions.
  - F. Culverts in the access road will not be necessary.
- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS IN A ONE-MILE RADIUS.
  - A. Water wells Rancher water well located approximately 1/4 mile east of location.
  - B. Disposal wells None known.
  - C. Drilling wells None known.
