Dear Mr. Gum:

Pursuant to Division Rule 111, Santa Fe Snyder Corporation applies for approval of directional drilling for the following well:

Roaring Springs "14" Fed Well No. 2 <u>Surface Location</u>: 660 feet FNL & 1680 feet FEL <u>Penetration Point</u>: 660 feet FNL & 1680 feet FEL <u>Terminus</u>: 660 feet FNL & 660 feet FWL §14, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico

The well will be drilled to test the Cisco/Canyon Formation (South Dagger Draw-upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool). The pool rules provide for 320 acre spacing, with wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the well unit. The Project Area/Spacing Unit for the well will be the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Section 14, which has previously been communitized. The Producing Area for the proposed well is completely within the 660 feet setback area, and thus the well's location is orthodox under Rule 111.

Attached is a copy of the Sundry Notice for the well, which includes a Form C-102 and a directional drilling prognosis. The  $N\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 14 is comprised of federal land, and the Sundry Notice has been submitted to the Bureau of Land Management for approval.

The N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Section 14 will be simultaneously dedicated to the following wells:
