A Public Protection Plan will not be required on this site because:

- 1.) The 100 ppm Roe does not exceed 3,000 feet.
- 2.) The 100 ppm Roe does not exceed 50 feet and include any occupied residence, school, church, park, school bus stop, place of business, or other area where the public could reasonably be expected to frequent.
- 3.) The 500 ppm Roe is not greater than 50 feet.
