1. Set sand plug across Lower Strawn Fm. perfs. (9909' - 9923': OA) to 9870'.
2. Check sand fill w/ slick line.
3. RU & sand frac Upper Strawn Fm. perfs. (9724' - 9737': OA) w/ 20k# - 40k# Sintered Ba.
4. Flow back & CU frac. Obtain 1 day SITP.
5. RU Coiled Tubing unit & c/o sand to 9974' PBD.

Evaluate well performance. Install gas compressor if necessary to keep well unloaded.

If productivity is low then:

6. MIRU Pullin Unit. Release On-Off Tool. Kill well w/ packer fluid. ND Tree & NU BOPE
 7. Release packer & POOH. LD packer & tools. RIH w/ tubing OA to 9923'. ND BOPE & NU Tree.
- Resume Strawn Production.
