The Sundry Notices requested the wells be reclassified as oil wells rather than gas wells due to a decline in the gas production on each well. After reviewing the request it was determined that no action be taken on the request since the determination of the classification of a well as gas or oil is under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD).
