

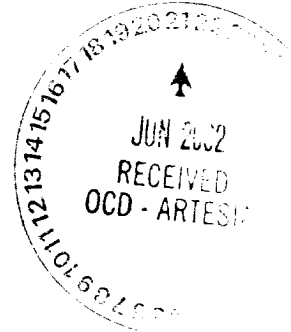

Dear Sir or Madam:

Please accept this request for exemption from OCD Rule 402, requiring an annual shut-in pressure test on natural gas wells. The subject well produces a substantial amount of water, lifted by an electric submersible pump. When shut-in, a fluid level will rise in the wellbore and when returned to production, normal gas production is delayed until the well is once again stabilized.
