I represent Pogo Producing Company ("Pogo"). Enclosed is an APD for the above well, which is submitted for the Division's approval. (A C-102 is being prepared, and will be submitted to you tomorrow.)

The proposed well is within the oil-potash area, and the affected potash lessee is Mississippi Potash, Inc. ("MPI"). MPI originally objected to the location by letter dated March 2, 1998 (copy enclosed).
