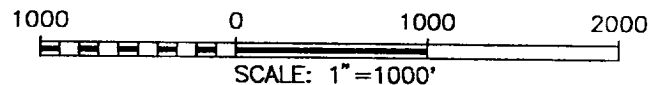
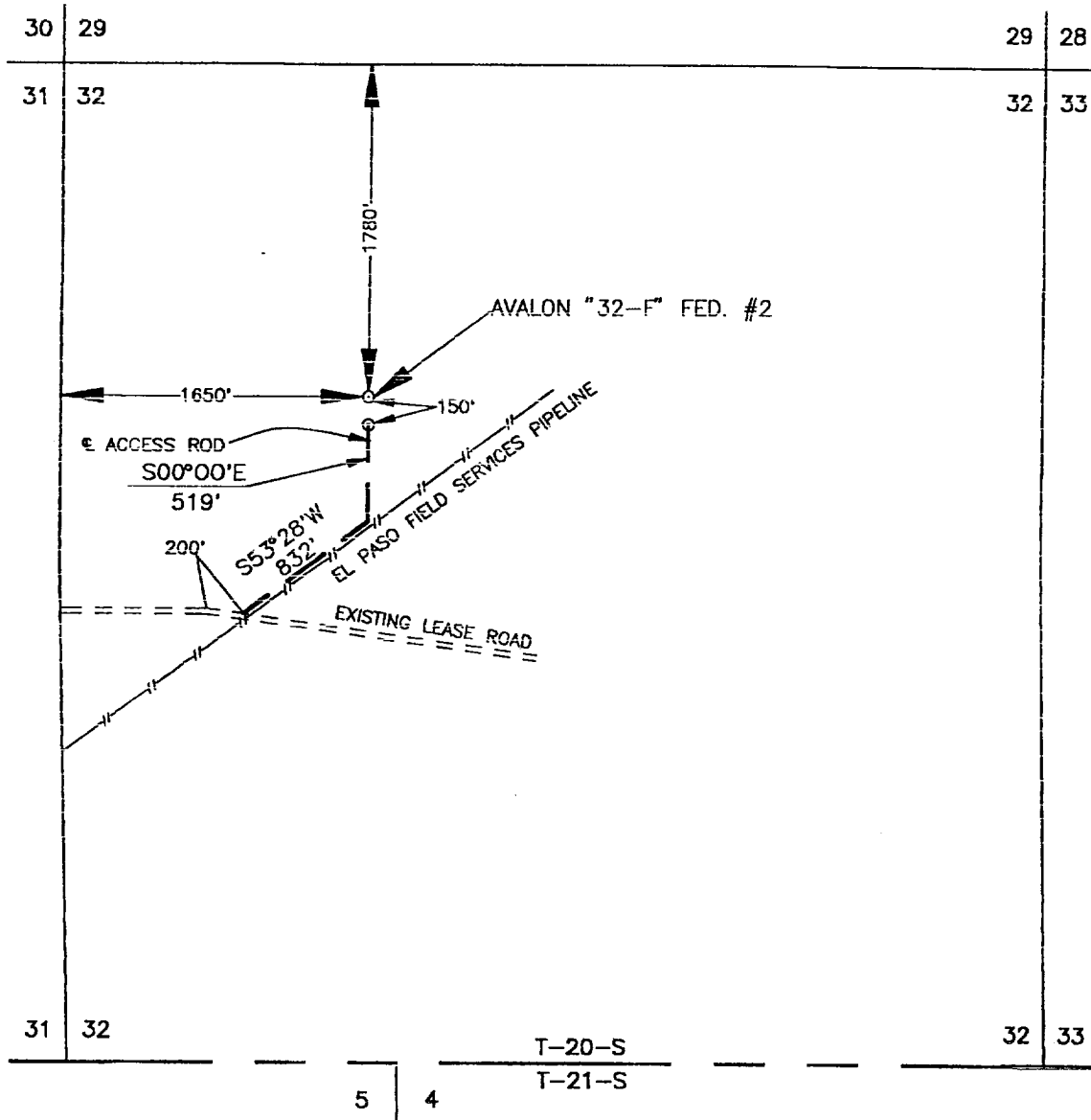

**b. Description of Undertaking:**

The proposed alternate Avalon "32-F" Federal Number 2 well location is staked 1780 ft FNL and 1650 ft FWL in Section 32, T.20S., R.27E. The original well location was staked 1980 ft FNL and 1980 ft FWL, the location was moved per BLM request. The impact area for the proposed alternate well location is an area 200 ft by 200 ft. The proposed access road is 600 ft long with an impact area of 50 ft by 600 ft. The proposed access road begins on the south side of the well location and trends 600 ft south to an existing lease road.

**c. Environmental Setting** NRCS soil designation: vegetative community: etc.:

The project area is located on the North side of a low rise, in shallow sandy loams with Ogallala gravels and exposure of limestone caliche. Vegetation in the area consists of little leaf sumac, acacia, grass, and creosote. Elevation is 3197 ft.


During the current survey, no cultural resources were encountered.
