


I.O.2 consists of 7 circular objects which appear to be can lids, 4-3/16 inch diameter; each has a square hole ½ inch on a side of, 3 sides have been cut and the flap was pushed inward. Vegetation consists of mesquite, juniper, creosote bush, javelina bush, narrow-leaf yucca, sotol, cholla, prickly pear, barrel cactus, horse creeper, snakeweed and grama grass. I.O.2 was found in the SW1/4NE1/4NE1/4SW1/4, in Section 10, T.22S., R.25E.

16. Management Summary (Recommendations):

During the survey, two isolated finds was encountered. Their research potential has been exhausted through field recordation. Therefore, **archaeological clearance is recommended** for the Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. proposed **Revelation "10M" Federal Number 1** well location, with no stipulations.
