- 11. <u>Surface Ownership</u>
  - A. The well site is owned by the Bureau of Land Management.
  - B. Road routes have been approved and the surface location will be restored as directed by the BLM.

- A. The project is located mostly on a northeast facing rocky slope with limestone outcrops with shallow rocky loam in the southwest, old alluvium in the northeast. Vegetation consists of mesquite, juniper, creosote bush, javelina bush, narrow-leaf yucca, sotol, cholla, prickly pear, barrel cactus, horse crippler, snakeweed and grama grass.
- B. There is no permanent water in the immediate area.
- C. There are no nearby residences.
- D. Land use is for oil and gas production, grazing and hunting.
- E. A Cultural Resources Examination has been completed by Southern New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., report number SNMAS-01NM-550, and forwarded to the BLM office in Carlsbad, New Mexico.
