Devon-SFS respectfully requests permission to close the unused pit on the Right Hand Canyon 34 Federal #4 location. We plan to fill in the pit and use the extra area as pad to accommodate the closed loop equipment necessary to drill the well. We will also build up the area from the outside corner of the reserve pit area to the lease road so that trucks can enter and leave location to haul off drill cuttings. We will haul the cuttings to the Old Ranch Knoll 8 Federal #5 cuttings pit located in Section 8, T22S, R24E.

Please see the attached diagram which is a plat of the Right Hand Canyon 34 Federal #4 location pad once we fill in the reserve pit and build up the area from the corner of the reserve pit to the entrance road. The 34-4 location pad is smaller than what we "normally" build but still of ample size to accommodate the rig.

The only "problem" we will have is rigging up the derrick. The vee-door side of location is 36' shorter than we normally build. This 36' is only used for maneuvering the truck dollied to the crown section. To set the derrick we will simply have to hold the crown section with two winch trucks at right angles to the derrick near the crown section. The location has ample room for this operation and safety will not be compromised as a result.

In order to provide additional room on the Right Hand Canyon 34 Federal #4 location some of the non-essential equipment will be placed on the Right Hand Canyon 34 Federal #2 location which is less than 1/4 mile to the SW.
