We plan to circulate cement to surface on the 9 5/8" casing string. The cement top will be brought to approximately 500' above Wolfcamp on the 7" casing string.

Devon Energy proposes to drill a Penn gas well to TD 8,600'± for commercial quantities. If the well is deemed noncommercial, the well bore will be plugged and abandoned per Federal regulations.
