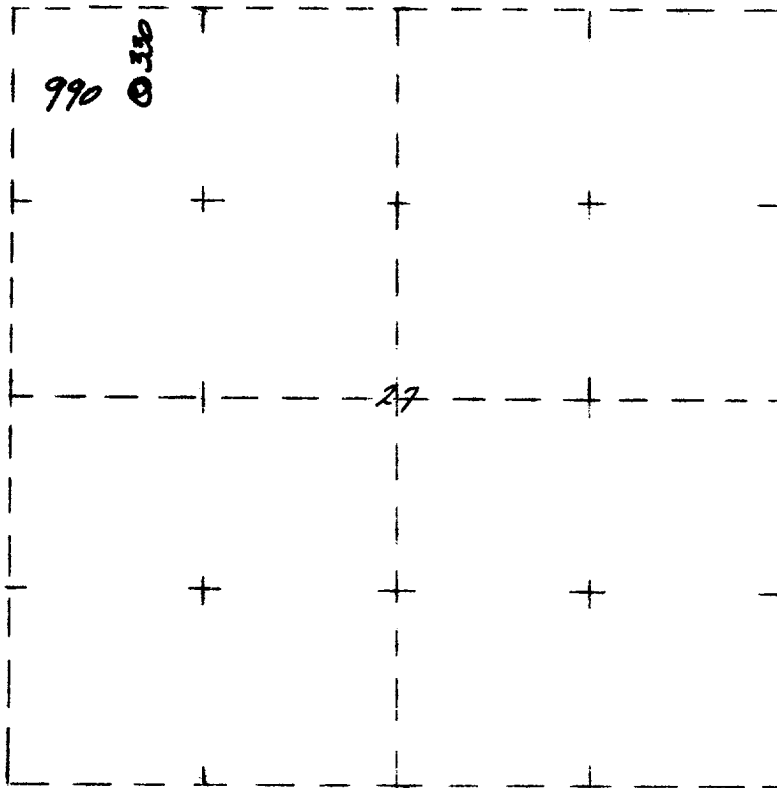

Operator Lease Well


