Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated October 1, 1948, covering your No. 6 Bradley well on the subject land in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, section 11, T. 24 S., R. 26 E., Black River Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. To furnish the U. S. Geological Survey with sample description log from the top of the salt to total depth,
3. The production string of casing shall be cemented with not less than 100 sacks of cement preceded with mud circulated to the surface.
