NMOCD Rule 705.C. is quoted for your information:

*705.C. Abandonment of Injection Operations*

- (1) Whenever there is a continuous 1-year period of non-injection into any injection project, storage project, salt water disposal well, or special purpose injection well, such project or well shall be considered abandoned, and the authority for injection shall automatically terminate ipso facto. [2-1-78...2-1-96]*
- (2) For good cause shown, the Division Director may grant an administrative extension or extensions of injection authority as an exception to Paragraph (1) above. [2-1-78...2-1-96]*

It is therefore requested that you furnish this office form C-104 changing well status from injection to producing.
