OPERATORS MONTHLY REPORT OF OPERATIONS

Mr. E. H. Wells, State Geologist,
Carlsbad, New Mexico.

Dear Sir:

Referring to our No. 1 Grandi Well, located in Section 26, Township 22 South, Range 27 East N.M.P.M., we desire to report to your office operations on said well as follows up to December first, 1932.

You have been previously advised by us that we took this well over from the New Mexico Potash and Chemical Company, said company having operated same on our lease for potash. A report of their operations we are advised has been filed in your office.

We commenced at 505 feet and straight rimmed this hole down with 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch tools to the bottom of their core hole at 1392 feet.

There was no water in this hole when we took it over.

At 1392 feet this hole was reduced to 6-5/8 inches and drilling was continued with these tools to a total depth of 1757 feet.

We are informed that you already have a log of this well down to 1392 feet. We therefore furnish you herewith with a log of the formations from 1392 feet to 1757 feet as follows:
