Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Filled hole with mud laden fluid from the bottom which was 1757 to 450. Then set five sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer and let stand for 24 hrs. Then pulled 404' of 8" pipe, then set 3 sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer and let stand for 12 hours. Then filled with mud laden fluid to 208 and set 10 sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer and let stand for 24 hours. Then pulled 10" pipe and filled with mud laden fluid to 32' and set 10 sacks of cement and let stand for 12 hours. Then filled with earth to the surface and set a piece of 3-5/16" pipe in concrete for marker. Filled all hole and pits around the well location and left it in a level condition
