CORE DATA - JANUARY 1959

- Core No. 4 11,640-11,691' - Rec'd 51' including 29' lime, 2' sand with slight porosity, 2' shale, 7' sand with slight porosity and 11' shale, dolomite and chert.
- Core No. 5 11,778-11,803' - Rec'd 25' including 12' dense lime and dolomite, 3' sand with no show or porosity and 10' dense lime and dolomite.
- Core No. 6 11,806-11,815' - Rec'd 1' lime and 8' black chert.
- Core No. 7 11,897-11,919' - Rec'd 21' including 8' fine-coarse grained sand and shale in streaks, 1-1/2' coal and 11-1/2' fine-medium grained sand with slight porosity and vertical fractures with no show.
- Core No. 8 11,919-11,940' - Rec'd 21' including 4-1/2' sand with some bleeding gas, 1' tight sand and 15-1/2' soft shale with dolomite streaks.
