Attached are three copies of an open flow potential test on the State John M. Kelly "B" No. 1, Unit N, Section 27, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It will be seen that only two flowing rates were obtained for this potential. Several attempts have been made to obtain a potential on this well as specified by the Oil Conservation Commission, but all were unsuccessful. A slight amount of water is produced with the gas and at low flowing rates it was impossible to prevent freezing of the well head. As no market is available for the gas at the present time, no heating or separation equipment has been installed.

Since the volume of gas produced is small and both stabilized flow rates obtained are within ten per cent of the calculated absolute open flow potential, little error is possible. It is respectfully requested that the attached potential test be accepted in lieu of the testing specified by the Oil Conservation Commission.
