NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T. 24 S., R. 27 E.

Apparently, we have no reports to
the State Geologist on the SG forms for this well.
Will you kindly investigate and advise me if you
have any regular reports and the present status of
the well. I am assuming that the bond should not
be cancelled until the well, if drilled, is plugged
and abandoned according to an approved program.
