We have in the files of the State Geologist a bond of Pecos Valley Drilling Company as principal and Great American Indemnity Company as surety in the amount of \$2500.00 covering the well in question which is specified being in the FE4, NW4 of Section 52, T. 24 S., R. 27 E.

Apparently, we have no reports to the State Geologist on the SG forms for this well. Will you kindly investigate and advise me if you have any regular reports and the present status of the well. I am assuming that the bond should not be cancelled until the well, if drilled, is plugged and abandoned according to an approved program.
