Cement plug (15 sacks) set @ 2467' after bridging back to 2467', another plug @ 1750' of 10 sacks, another @ 1400' of 10 sacks, another @ 150' of 10 sacks, hole was bridged at each depth given. A 10 sack plug was placed in the top of hole at which point a 4" pipe extending 4' above ground was placed.
