NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Keck Community Well No. 1 in S W of Sec. N.W. of Sec. 33, T. 23 S, R. 28 E, N. M. P. M., Eddy Oil Field, Eddy County. We plan to commence work on \_\_\_\_\_, 19\_\_\_\_\_.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

**No oil producing formations discovered.**

The present condition of the well is as follows:

**15 1/2" Casing set at 208'**

**12 1/2" Casing set at 863'**

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Well was plugged back from 3002' to 2600' with rock and cement, in September, 1927. The 15 1/2" and 12 1/2" casing will not be pulled. Plugging operations were approved by R. L. Halley, State Oil & Gas Inspector.
