Enclosed is a copy of a letter
to the State Land Commissioner, J. F. Hinkle and a
copy of my reply.

Please advise me if the well in
question was properly plugged and the date of
final abandonment which I presume may not be the
date, February 4th, specified in the "Notice of
Intention to Abandon Well" applied for by Mr.
Keck and which was approved by you.

In reality a report should be
submitted on Form SG-106 entitled "Miscellaneous
Reports on Wells" in regard to abandonment and I
suggest that this procedure be followed in the
future, but not in this particular case. Form
SG-104 "Notice of Intention to Abandon Well" of
course outlines the plugging program but it may
not indicate that the well has been finally
abandoned.
