Under date of April 19, 1927 our company executed a \$1000 Oil & Gas Driller's bond for Mr. Keck covering W. M. Keck Community Well No. 1 on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, Tp 23 S Rg 28 E owned by Chas. P. Pardue, et al. We now have letter from James P. Sullivan, State Oil & Gas Inspector, written from Hobbs, N. M. under date of Feb. 4th reading as follows:
