FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

My telephone conversation with Mr. L. A. Hanson, Artesia, New Mexico, on the 17th of April, 1952, instruction for plugging of well, as follows:

Fill from total depth back to 2855' with mud and set bridge at 2855', put in 10 sacks cement plug from 2855', fill with mud up to 2700', put in bridge and 10 sacks cement plug. After pulling 7" pipe, fill hole full of mud from casing seat up to below 325', then 10 sacks cement plug. Pull 13-3/8" fill with mud and set a regulation marker 4" pipe 5' above surface, in cement, pit filled, location cleaned up for inspection.
