Plan to cement 5-1/2", 11 1/4 new seamless casing at 2745 feet with 200 sack, and through two-stage tool at 1029 feet with 100 sack. Will let set 48 hours. Will then drill out plug and bail test for shut-off at two-stage tool. If satisfactory, will drill out shoe and bail test for shut-off. If this test satisfactory, will drill ahead with cable tools.
