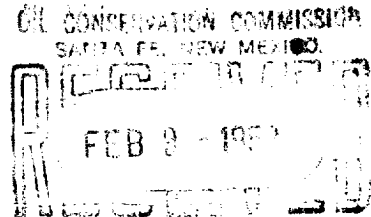

- _____ (3) The well has been abandoned for oil drilling purposes and properly converted into a water well.


