Dear Sir:

At the request of Mr. E. H. Wells, State Geologist I am writing to each and every Oil Company who are operating in the State of New Mexico, asking them to comply with the State rules in connection with posting of wells, such as putting signs on all locations, giving the numbers of the wells and the names of the leases. The State also requires danger signs to be posted around locations where oil companies are operating on the State land, especially where gas is escaping and oil is exposed in pits. The State also requires that all sump holes and pits where salt water or oil is exposed should be fenced to prevent stock from getting poisoned or falling into them.
