5 1/2 inch casing will be set and cemented at total depth if well is productive.

All surface waters will be protected and the casing will be set and cemented in accordance with the rules and regulations of the U. S. Geological Survey, Artesia, New Mexico.

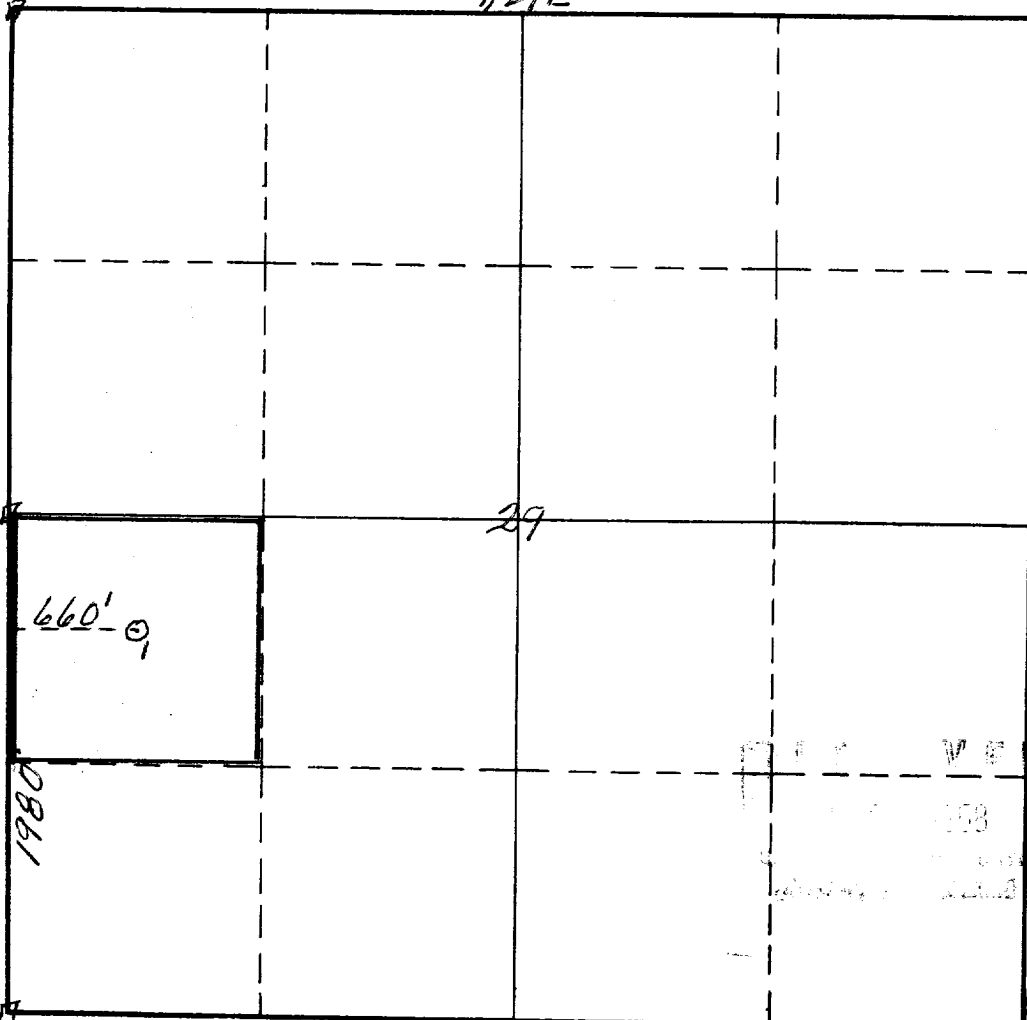
