This well was drilled to TD 5190' 2-17-61 and no oil or gas was encountered in commercial quantities. It is intended to plug and abandon this well in the following manner: Set plugs at 4368-4464' W/25 sx, 4115-4185' W/20 sx, 849-920' W/20 sx, 321-380' W/20 sx and 15 sx at surface, erect a 4" marker extending 4' above surface with the well name and location inscribed thereon and restore the location to the original condition. Verbal approval to do the preceeding work was recieved from Mr. Joe D. Ramey, Proration Mgr, NMICC at Hobbs on February 17, 1961.
