The following plugging program was followed: The 10-3/4" pipe was pulled and the hole mudded, the following plugs were set: 75' cement plug 1030-1100'; 50' cement plug 700-800'; 50' cement plug 500-600'; 10' cement plug at ~~the~~ surface.
 One 30' joint of 10-3/4" pipe left at surface of hole in which cement cement plug was placed.
