Well plugged and abandoned May 27, 1964 to 1213 feet. No commercial shows of oil or gas. 700 feet of 10-3/4" pipe was pulled from the hole. The hole was sealed by Benton Cement Co. and the following plugs set:

1213' - 1113'; 720' - 620' ; 25' plug at surface.

No casing remained in hole.
