Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of Form C-128 showing the dedication of 320 acres to the subject well.

At this time we should like to point out that Commission Rule 104, B., 1, (b) as revised by Order R-2707 provides in part that, "In the event gas production is encountered in a well which was projected as an oil well and which is located accordingly but does not conform to the above gas well location rule, it shall be necessary for the operator to bring the matter to a hearing before approval for the production of gas can be given." Please be advised that the subject well, being located closer than 660 feet to the side boundary of the tract, does not conform to the rule. Therefore, it will be necessary for Union Oil Company of California to obtain approval of this non-standard gas well location before an allowable may be assigned the well.
