Dear Mr. Gressett:

Confirming your telephone conversation of this date with Mr. McLenore, we request a test oil allowable in the amount of 2,000 barrels be assigned our James "A" Well No. 1 - Wildcat Oil - which is located in Unit O, Section 2, T-22-S, R-30-E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This temporary allowable is necessary in order to provide adequate tank room for complete testing of this well. Current testing is being made of the Strawn formation from perforations 12,155' to 12,167'. Production is 50° gravity oil after weathering with a gas-oil ratio of 10,000 to one.

Western Oil Transportation Company, Box 3119, Midland, Texas, is the designated gatherer of this crude.

Your consideration in assigning this temporary test allowable will be appreciated.
