Gentlemen:

The following is our suggested mud program for your proposed re-entry in Section 31, 23-26, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Casing: 8 5/8" - 5462'

Drill cement plugs with brine water to bottom of 8 5/8". Check and condition mud in hole to 9600'.

Viscosity: 33 to 34 seconds with FLOSAL Filtrate: As needed (25 to 30) with IMPERMEX

Use HY-SEAL (paper) for seepage.

<u>9650' - 12,100' Estimated TD</u>: Same fluid as above decreasing filtrate to 12cc to 15cc with IMPERMEX. Increase viscosity with FLOSAL as needed for good hole conditions at all times to total depth. Weight: 10 ppg. Add BAROID if higher weight is needed. Suggest pretreating system with FIBERTEX before going into Devonian.

The estimated mud cost for this program is \$5000 to \$6000 unless severe loss of circulation occurs.
