Dear Sirs:

Please refer to your notice to this office dated January 14, 1972 and to our telephone conversation regarding this well on March 7, 1972. Attached for your review and approval are two copies of NMOCC Form C-122 reporting the results of a 24 hour 1 point AOF back pressure test on the captioned well. As I advised you last Tuesday this well has been making formation water for some time with the volume ranging between 20 bbls. and 40 BPD. The well's diminished flow capacity results in this water being produced erratically or by heads. This characteristic prevents short term stabilization necessary to perform the conventional 4 point back pressure test and necessitated the 1 point test attached. Since two separate attempts to complete conventional AOF tests have proved unsuccessful we respectfully request that this 24 hour test be accepted in satisfaction of requirements of NMOCC Rule 401.
