Gentlemen:

Texas American would like to request a new pool designation of Sand Dune Lower Penn for the subject well.

An attempt was made to dually complete this well from the two perforated intervals shown on the attached plat. A collapsed joint of tubing above the top packer and a leak in the sliding sleeve between the packers make producing the two zones separately impossible. To repair this equipment, heavy mud would have to be pumped into the well to kill it and this would undoubtedly damage both perforated intervals.

The producing limits on this new pool should be from 14,030' to 14,880'. The proration unit should include the west 320 acres of Section 14.

I am enclosing diagrams of the well and completion equipment plus logs on the two gas wells with completion intervals marked.
