Gentlemen:

This is a supplement to my letter of December 17, 1970, to provide additional information that you requested by telephone this date.

All the equipment that was shown on the diagram attached to the previous correspondence will remain in the well and the gas will be produced through the long string of tubing.

Several times, before the leak developed between the two packers in the long string, the upper zone was opened up with the following results:

- 11-9-70: SITP 5300 psi, opened up on 1" choke and bled to 350 psi in 30 min.
- 11-12-70: SITP 5200 psi, opened up on 1" choke and bled to 300 psi in 30 min.

Natural Gas Pipeline Co. personnel have indicated they will start laying the approximately one mile of pipeline to connect this well next week. The line pressure will be approximately 1000psi and the anticipated gas sales volume will be 3,000 MCF/D.
