Commission Rule 401 requires the filing of Form C-122 within sixty days after initial connection of a well to a gas transportation facility.

Initial gas sales from this well was 28,022 MCF for March. The well was able to deliver only 16,469 MCF to the sale line during April, 1971.

We have attached copies of our daily gas well report from our pumper showing tubing, separator or gathering line pressure, choke size and an estimated daily flow rate averaging 300 MCFD from this well.

Since the well has been a disappointment, we ask you to accept this in lieu of the required Multipoint Back Pressure test.
