Mallon Oil Company took over operations of the O'Neill Federal No. 1 in October, 1993 from Pennzoil. The well had been temporarily abandoned since it was initially completed because a gas market was not available for the sour gas that the well produces.

Mallon Oil Company is currently performing extensive field work on wells in this area and the O'Neill Federal No. 1 is included in this work schedule for evaluation and analysis to determine if the well can be produced economically.

Mallon Oil Company requests that an extension of time be granted for the well to be temporarily abandoned so that Mallon Oil Company can adequately test and evaluate this well. Mallon Oil Company intends to perform casing integrity tests within 90 days of approval.
