Drilled to total depth of 10,921'. Set open hole bridge plug at 10,600' w/50 sz. cement on top of bridge plug. Tagged top cement plug at 10,525'. Set 5-1/2" 170 N-80 L7&C casing at 10,405' and cemented w/670 sz. cl. "H" 3/4X CPE2. Plug down 6:00 a.m., 10-3-70. Float held. 1st DV tool @ 8,510', opened DV tool at 7:30 a.m. Circulated 4 hrs. and cemented w/230 sz. cl. "C" 4X gel. 2nd DV tool @ 5302'. Cemented w/350 sz. cl. "C" 4X gel. Job completed 4:45 p.m. 10/3/70. WOC 86 hrs.

10/7/70: Drilled out both DV tools and pressure tested casing w/4800 psi for 30 minutes, no leak-off.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
